

# Browsealoud Customer Support Documentation

## What is Browsealoud?

Browsealoud is a free program for Kid's College customers. The Browsealoud tool reads aloud the words on a website, highlighting each word as it is read aloud. This is a great tool for assisting new readers, ESL students and readers who have difficulty seeing text on a webpage.

## How To Download and Run Browsealoud

1. There is no cost for Kid's College customers to download Browsealoud.
2. You need an internet connection to download and install Browsealoud.
3. When connected to the Internet, click on this link or any of the Browsealoud images you see on the Kid's College website:



You will be taken to the Browsealoud website in order to download Browsealoud:

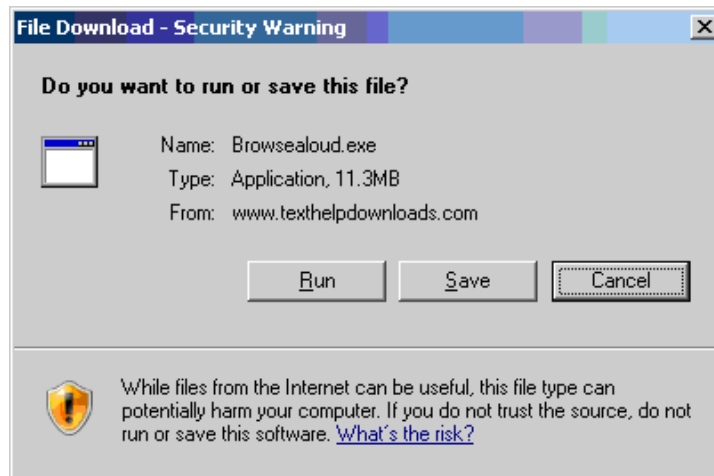

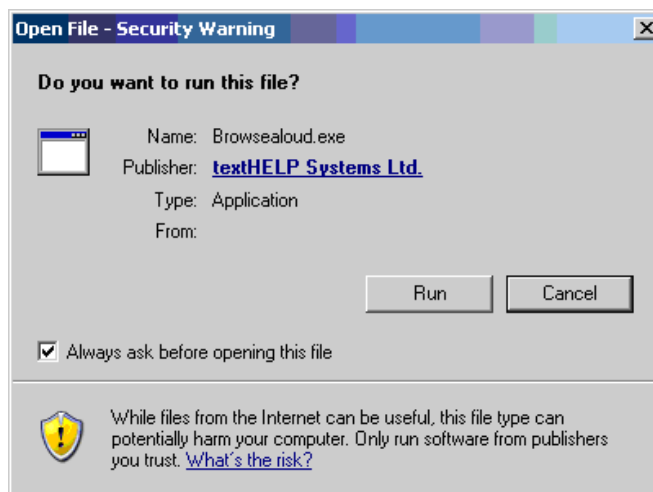
4. Click on PC Download or Mac Download, depending on what type of computer you have.

5. When the File Download panel appears (like in the picture below) click on SAVE (save the file locally on your PC). Do NOT click Run:



Save Browsealoud to a location on your computer that will be easy for you will remember.

6. After Browsealoud has finished downloading, close the “Download Complete” dialog box. Locate and double-click on the Browsealoud.exe file on your computer. The below message may appear. Please uncheck “Always ask before opening this file” to prevent this message from appearing in the future, and then click Run.



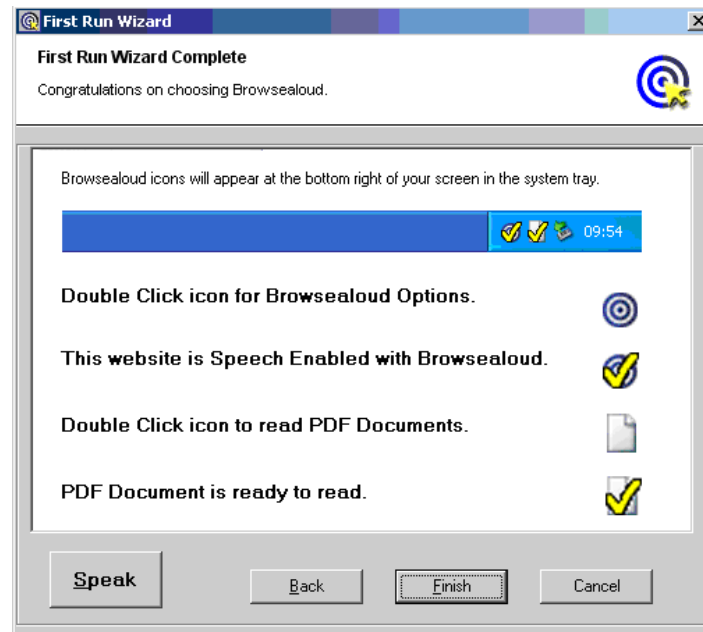
7. The first screen you will see is the License Agreement. You need to choose the "I accept the license agreement" radio button, then click Next.



8. A "Read Me" dialog box will appear, containing some accessibility information. Click Next.



9. You will then see the final dialog box explaining the **Browsealoud Icons** as shown below:



10. Click Finish.

11. Browsealoud is now running on your computer, and is ready to read the Kid's College website for you.
