

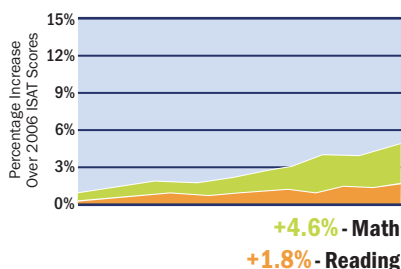
Chicago Public School District

- ▶ 13.7% are limited-English proficient


On the 2007 IL Standards Achievement Test (ISAT), Chicago Public Schools improved their scores as a district by +1.8% in Reading and +4.6% in Math.

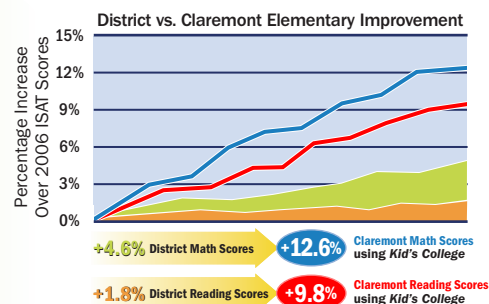

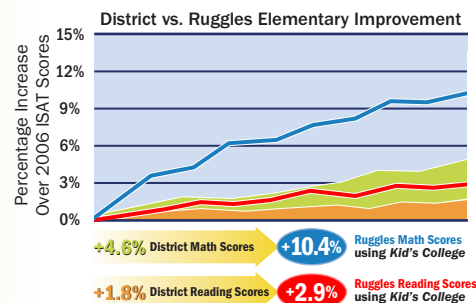
Claremont Academy ranked in the Top 30 Chicago Public Schools with the largest gains in 2007.

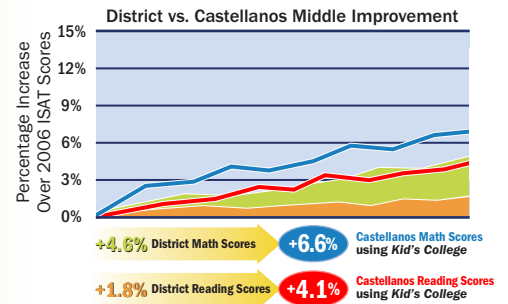
