Summary of the Education Stimulus Act (ARRA): \$72 BILLION IN DIRECT FUNDING FOR EDUCATION

SCHEDULE

- ▶ Funds must be used by end of 2010/2011 school year, except for IDEA Stimulus Funds which must be used by end of 2011/2012.
- ▶ 50% of Title I and IDEA funds dispersed to school districts by **April 30, 2009** for immediate spending.
- ▶ Balance of all Title I and IDEA Stimulus Funds dispersed to school districts by **July 1, 2009**.
- ▶ All other Stimulus Funds (Title IID, Title V, State Fiscal Stabilization Funds) dispersed to school districts by **July 1, 2009**.
- ▶ Additionally, NCLB funding will be available **June 30 and September 30, 2009** and twice/year thereafter.

AMOUNTS

- ▶ **State Stabilization Funds** - \$40 billion to be used by the states toward education reforms to help prevent education cuts. Portions may be used for school modernization.
- ▶ **Title I** - \$13 billion, including \$3 billion for Title I School Improvement Programs.
- ▶ **IDEA** (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act) - \$12 billion
- ▶ **Incentive Grants** - \$5 billion in competitive grants distributed to states exhibiting aggressive efforts toward higher standards, quality assessments, robust data systems and teacher quality initiatives. Includes \$650 million to fund school systems and non-profits with strong track records in improving student achievement.
- ▶ **Other Education Investments** - \$2 billion, including pay for performance, teacher quality investments, technology grants, data systems, vocational rehab, work study and Impact Aid.
